



The F-84 is a midwing, single-engine fighter-bomber. Its equitapered, blunt-tipped wing has moderate positive dihedral. Retractable rocket mounts disappear into the wing and some modifications carry wing-tip drop tanks. A bubble-type canopy is mounted forward on the fuselage. The nose (jet intake) and tail (jet outlet) of the fuselage are squared off. The blunt-tipped horizontal stabilizer has the same general shape as the wing, while the round-tipped vertical stabilizer is tapered and curved. The horizontal stabilizer is joined directly into the vertical stabilizer above the fuselage. A small fin fairing and ventral fin are incorporated in the tail section.
